are invited to participate in 2022 FAI Junior World Championships For Free Flight Model Aircraft 2018, **if still eligible**.

Supporters, helpers and spectators are also invited.

Each Country (National Aero-club/National Federation), member of the FAI-CIAM may enter a team consisting of:

- team manager, team manager assistant

- junior competitors (age limit 18 years in the year 2022): maximum 3 competitors or a maximum of 4 competitors if at least one competitor is female;

- official helpers, supporters.

ANTI-DOPING

If a competitor has to take, for a medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

DATE AND PLACE

July 25 to July 30 2022, Valchitran, Pordim, Bulgaria.

COMPETITION RULES

Current rules of the FAI Sporting Code, section 4, volume ABR and F1 Edition 2022.

AGE OF JUNIORS AND THEIR HELPERS:

Sporting Code, paragraph B.3.4: "A competitor is considered to be a **junior** up to and including the calendar year in which he attained the age of 18."

SPORTING LICENSES

Each competitor must possess FAI Sporting License valid for 2022. The licences must be on the FAI database.

The official languages are Bulgarian and English.

TIMEKEEPERS

Organizers will provide local timekeepers. Each participating country may enter a one timekeeper and these timekeepers will be preferably used. The intention to enter a timekeeper should be announced in the Entry Form. All these timekeepers should speak basic technical English. The Organizers will provide accommodation, meals and Banquet together with the local timekeepers for the full official period of the contest from 24 July (dinner) till 31 July (breakfast). They should act in all contest days, attend briefings for timekeepers and have own binocular, tripod and stopwatch. Each team will have the right to have any of their group act as a third timekeeper on their flights both in rounds and fly offs. Any small team unable to take this option will have a third timekeeper provided by Organizers for their fly off flights.

AWARDS

FAI medals and diplomas and cups will be awarded to the winner, second and third place competitors in each class F1A, F1B and F1P, first, second and third place female competitors in each class F1A, F1B and F1P and first, second and third place teams in each class F1A, F1B and F1P. Winner Team Junior General Classification for classes F1A, F1B and F1P

COVID-19

Team Managers will present (if needed) to the Registration for verification, a list of participants and copies of the vaccination / testing documents. Unvaccinated people will be tested periodically. More information will be in next Bulletins.



FLYING SITE LOCATION

Flying site – field "Valchitran", 25 km East-South from the city of Pleven, 10 km to the South from the city of Pordim. Grass area 2x0,8 km and open space around for 2 km.

HOW TO REACH PORDIM

•by car (freeway from Sofia 180 km, Pleven 25 km, Russe 140 km);

• by train from Belgrade, Istanbul; Bucharest. Pleven is on the railway from Europe, via Sofia, to Istanbul.

• by air to Sofia, then by car to Pleven. Organized transportation from Sofia airport to Pleven is possible.

HOW TO REACH SOFIA

There are direct flights to Sofia from: Amsterdam, Belgrade, Berlin, Budapest, Bucharest, Frankfurt, Helsinki, Istanbul, London, Manchester, Madrid, Moscow, Paris, Prague, Rome, Warsaw.

The entry fee covers participation in the World Championships, T-shirts, souvenirs and gifts.

ATTENTION !!! While the competition, entrance into the Start Line area is allowed **ONLY** to those persons, who passed the official registration (Competitors, Team Managers, Assistants TM, Helpers, Timekeepers, FAI Jury, Organizers) and have registration badge. All other persons should be out of 25 m zone.

PAYMENTS

MEAL

Breakfast, and dinner at the accommodation place (see below).

INSURANCE

The organizer will provide third party insurance to all participants of Championship for accidents involving injury to others of damage to property according to the host country legislation during competition. Participants should provide their own health insurance to cover accident and illness.
